Leviticus 19:36

You shall have just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin: I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt.

As I write this, my calendar is filling up - quickly - and I find myself feeling little apprehensive about how I am going to keep a sense of balance while getting it all done. I confess that I fall into the same trap that many do in our culture today - thinking that a full calendar points to a successful person - and as a person of faith - one that God is using! I admit that I have observed what many of my colleagues are doing, and often felt like a slacker in comparison.

With that in mind, when I read the passage from Leviticus above, I first read it as an affirmation of the need for balance in my life -probably because I feel like it is missing at the moment. In actuality, this passage is from a section of Leviticus pertaining to holiness in personal conduct - in specific - about not being dishonest in the standards of measurements used..... but I think for now I will take it as a reminder from God for me to strive for a healthy balance in my life.

It is something that I think we all need to be reminded of from time to time. Filling up our days with tasks- even those that make our hearts sing - while leaving little space for quiet and for God, is just not healthy, physically or spiritually. We don't need a full calendar to live a faithful and fulfilling life. There is a blessing in the regular rhythm of getting up - doing work of some sort - coming home - having dinner - spending time with family or alone and resting. It sounds dull - but in actually I think it provides the space that we need - space to see the blessings and beauty of life around us - space to see how and where God is present and might be calling us to discover and share something new.

My prayer for us all is that we will strive in all areas of our lives for a healthy balance - one that includes time for family, friends, silence, and God.
