The Safety Team report was presented by team member, Mike Hand.

- 1. There is a need to determine if the police department has a key available in their squad car in case of an emergency.
- 2. Greeters provide the first line of security.
- 3. Discussion about the installation of a wireless buzzer.
- 4. Further questions involve the use of cameras, budget needed and the authority of the safety team.

Moved and seconded to grant authority to the safety team members to stop someone from entering or request that they leave and if not compliant to notify police. **Motion passed.**

The team will move forward with guideline for the safety team procedures.

The group discussed a request from the bookkeeper/secretary to no longer publish the monthly newsletter, The Lamplighter. A possible alternative would be a bulletin insert on a scheduled basis. 
WARMEST GREETINGS AND GOOD WISHES
