This month I want to share with you what happens every Wednesday night here at the church with our children and youth. It is a time of fun, fellowship, modeling, and education that happens because of dedicated volunteers and a group of kids eager to come to church!

Pastor's Note

Our night actually starts at 4:30, with a small group of children, youth and adults that gather to practice so they may provide special music the third Sunday of the month in worship using their Ukuleles and voices. This is an opportunity to learn about the importance of things like practice, and working together, but more importantly, to learn about the importance of offering our very best to God in worship.

While the group meets to practice, taking place down the hall in the kitchen is meal preparation, provided by a dedicated group of workers (who would be happy to have you join them). At 5:30, after everyone has arrived, the group gathers at the entrance of the outreach center, and offers up a prayer of thanks and blessing to God for our meal-and then eats! It is a time to share and have fun. At the end of mealtime, in a new tradition we started this year, we gather at the kitchen window and say "Thank you" to those who provided the meal for us. (See picture). Then at 5:59 p.m., we head down the hall to the Christian education rooms for an hour of learning and growing in faith together.

The groups are currently broken up into two groups - Pre-k through 5th grade and 6th-12th grade. The younger group, led by four dedicated workers, focuses each month on a different story from the bible. For example, this past month, they looked at the story of the Prodigal Son. Each week, after sharing their highs and lows of the past week, they hear the story and then engage in a different activity: arts and crafts, science or games and community building — each based upon the scripture.

Meanwhile, the youth also start with highs and lows, and then engage in a monthly theme surrounding faith. This past month we explored their identity in Christ by looking at different scripture themes and stories in the bible, and engage in various activities.

This book is about learning how to "make peace with where you are right now." It's about learning from the past and then moving past it. It's about growing-personally, spiritually, and in our relationships with God and with others. If we think properly about growing older we'll never have to grow old.

Thinking About Becoming a Member?


HALLOWEEN FUN ALERT
